A Chenin Blanc with refreshing ripe melon and citrus fruits and a lovely, clean finish Glass 175ml £3.40 or 250ml £4.95 / Bottle £13.00

Crunchy red berry fruit character on the nose and palate in a refreshing off-dry style Glass 175ml £3.40 or 250ml £4.95 / Bottle £13.00

Old World

- Pinot Grigio delle Venezie Sartori, Veneto (Italy)**
Zingy and fresh with a tongue-tingling acidity which is also perfect as an apéritif £15.50
- Chablis Ropiteau, Burgundy (France)**
Ripe apples and brioche flavours with dry mineral notes £24.00
- Sancerre Domaine Serge Laporte, Loire (France)**
This Sancerre stands out for its aromatic intensity, citrus, exotic fruits and its perfectly balanced minerals, softness and acidity £25.00
- Piesporter Michelsberg, Mosel (Germany)**
Clean, fresh and medium-dry with light grape flavours £14.00
- Montebuena Rioja Bianco, Rioja Alavesa (Spain)**
Refreshing lemon and toffee-apple hints £15.50

New World

- CYT Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)**
Brilliant greenish-yellow in colour, this has varietal character with notes of peaches and citric apples - light and fresh £14.50
- Trivento Viognier (Argentina)**
Enticing fruit flavours jump out of the glass from this delightfully fragrant Argentinean Viognier £15.50
- Giesen Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (New Zealand)**
Distinctive blend of intense tropical fruit, vibrant citrus with aromas and flavours of dried herb - crisp, fresh acidity £23.00

Lebanon

- Château Musar White Gaston Hochar, Bekaa Valley**
Butterscotch, almond and vanilla on the palate, the finish of this wine has a slightly unexpected mineral note £25.75

New World

- Humboldt Coast (California)**
Great light and fresh wine from the very home of the style with bags of ripe, red fruits and a good touch of sweetness £14.50

Lebanon

- Château Musar Rosé, Gaston Hochar, Bekaa Valley**
A very subtle amber-coloured rosé, softly oaked with hints of almond, quince, apricot and wild flowers £24.00

Red Wines

Old World

- Montebuena Rioja Crainza, Rioja Alavesa (Spain)**
Classic Rioja character with beautifully-integrated sweet vanilla oak making this a persistent and balanced wine £21.50
- Fleurie Ropiteau, Beaujolais (France)**
Silky texture with ripe raspberry and vanilla-spiced aromas - sweet, rich fruit extraction with an elegant finish £20.50
- Châteauneuf du Pape 'Le Palais des Papes', Rhône (France)**
A high percentage of Grenache makes for a soft, early ripening wine with some enticing spice and a velvet finish £30.00

New World

- CYT Merlot (Chile)**
Brilliant ruby red with cherry, ripe pepper and soft cacao on the nose, elegant, rounded, good body with a long finish £14.50
- Trivento Malbec (Argentina)**
A bouquet of dark berry fruits leads to a mouthful of ripe, full-flavoured richness £15.50
- Wolf Blass President's Selection Shiraz (Southern Australia)**
Superb chocolaty oak and fruit nose with a rich, full-bodied fruit style and a long, pepper-spiced finish £26.00
- Giesen Pinot Noir, Marlborough (New Zealand)**
Vibrant red fruit aromas with spicy complexity - subtle texture and integrated sweet oak complemented by a rounded structure £23.00

Lebanon

- Château Musar Red, Gaston Hochar, Bekaa Valley**
Mature cherry and blackcurrant fruit with notes of chocolate, olives and figs and smooth tannins on the finish £27.50

Sparklers & Champagne

- Cava Pere Ventura Brut Imperial, Penedès (Spain)**
Fresh, clean and fruity with great bubbles and fresh acidity £20.50
- Cava Pere Ventura Rosado Brut, Penedès (Spain)**
A delightful rosé with lots of elegant, fresh strawberry fruit £20.50
- Prosecco IGT Sartori, Veneto (Italy)**
Italy's finest sparkling wine from the Veneto, with delicate fruit flavours and soft intensity £21.50
- Vollereaux Brut, Champagne (France)**
Light and delicate with a fine mousse, dry, crisp, and fresh £35.50
- Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label, Champagne (France)**
Well-known for being full-bodied, rich and fruity with great elegance and a delightfully long finish £48.00
